


The Latin name for Steelhead is Oncorhynchus mykiss, but the fish is more familiarly known as "Sea-Run Trout" or "Salmon Trout." Steelhead are native to the Columbia River and many other Pacific Northwest rivers and streams. The Steelhead species can be found in the wild from Kamchatka in Russia to the Mexico border, but they are best known among sport fishermen in the Pacific Northwest. In fact, Steelhead are often regarded as perhaps the hardest fighting freshwater game fish in North America.
